**LAND AT FINHAM PARK SCHOOL**

Please find enclosed plans and reports which combine to constitute an application for planning permission to provide training lights at Finham Park School.

The layout of the playing pitches, together with the provision of a Clubhouse at the school have recently been consented (application reference FUL/2018/3549) as part of the relocation of Trinity Guild Rugby Football Club from its current home at Rowley Road.

This application deals solely with proposed lighting for the junior playing pitch, which is located furthest away from residential receptors. The pitch has been specifically chosen in order to protect neighbouring amenity in line with the requirements of national planning policy and Policy CO1 of Coventry's Local Plan.

This application is supported by a Lighting Assessment and Lighting Diagram, both of which demonstrate that the proposed lighting design will minimise light pollution in all its forms and that "light trespass" outside of the sports field will be negligible.

Further, the lighting will be contained to the following operating hours: no more than three days a week; no more than two hours per day; and switched off no later than 9pm.

The playing facilities, including the Clubhouse and training lights will be shared between the school and the Trinity Guild Rugby Football Club. It is the intention that the Rugby Club will only be temporarily located at the school and as such, once the Rugby Club move to a permanent home, the lights will be retained for the benefit of the school.

In accordance with the Council's requirements the application fee has been paid to the Council separately.
