TEMPORARY PARKING & TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS MANOR ROAD, COVENTRY

Coventry City Council, under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (as amended), has made a temporary Order, the effect of the Order will prohibit vehicles from waiting, loading or unloading, entering, proceeding along Manor Road unless otherwise stated.

The Order will come into effect at 07:00 hours on Friday 12 March 2021 and is required for Station Master Plan and associated works to take place safely. The restriction will suspend the parking bays in the middle section of Manor Road and impose a bus gate (i.e bus, cycle, taxi, and motorbikes) to such extent when prescribed signs are displayed.

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS ALLESLEY OLD ROAD, COVENTRY

Coventry City Council, under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (as amended), intends to make a temporary Order, the effect of the Order would be to prohibit vehicles from waiting, loading or unloading, entering, proceeding along the entire length of Allesley Old Road unless otherwise stated.

The Order would come into effect at 07:00 hours on Friday 19 March 2021 and is required for the installation of 30mph roundels and electric charging bay points and associated works to take place safely. TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS KERESLEY ROAD, COVENTRY

Coventry City Council, under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (as amended), intends to make a temporary Order, the effect of the Order would be to prohibit vehicles from waiting, loading or unloading, entering, proceeding along Keresley Road unless otherwise stated.

The Order would come into effect on Saturday 20 March 2021 and is required for Telecoms Pole installation works to take place safely. The restriction would be to close Keresley Road in both directions between its junctions with The Scotchill and Kipling Road.
