**Re: Addendum to Arboricultural Impact Appraisal and Method Statement, Old Hall Hotel, Tamworth Road Coventry, 11245-AIA-AS**

I write regarding the proposed redevelopment of the above site and the potential requirement for additional car parking spaces.

I can confirm that sketch plan option 2, (by Howl Associates Ltd dated 30 August 2011), has been drawn following detailed consultation with me regarding the tree constraints.

The proposed layout does result in the loss of a small number of low amenity trees which could easily be replaced with significant landscaping. A number of the new car parking spaces are also within root protection areas of trees which are to be retained. I am confident that provided special construction techniques are used for these spaces, they will not have any significant adverse impact on the long term health of the trees. The precise details of this could be conditioned by the council to ensure trees are not affected by the work.
